#### **Location and Access**

Located in the Elkhorn Estates, 4½ miles south of Flagstaff and one-half mile north of Mountainaire. It is accessible from I-17 via Exit 331, then northeast about three-quarters mile on the Old Munds Highway to the Elkhorn Estates gate. Old Munds Highway is paved and the Elkhorn Estates streets are cinder.











